### Risk Point Value

Possibility of Occurrence	Will Happen Over 90%	Extreme 90%<>75%	High 75%<>25%	Moderate 25%<>10%	Low Under 10%
Highly Possible	8	7	6	5	4
Very Possible	7	6	5	4	3
Possible	6	5	4	3	2
Low Possibility	5	4	3	2	1
Very Low Possibility	4	3	2	1	0

### Score Interpretations

<b>6 to 8</b>	<b>These risks are extreme. Countermeasure actions to mitigate these risks should be implemented immediately.</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>The risks are very high. Countermeasure actions to mitigate these risks should be implemented as soon as possible.</b>
<b>3 to 4</b>	<b>These risks are moderate. Countermeasure actions to mitigate these risks should be implemented in the near term.</b>
<b>1 to 2</b>	<b>The risks are low. Countermeasure actions to mitigate these risks should be implemented as required.</b>
<b>0</b>	<b>These currently pose no risk but should continue to be monitored.</b>
